

A Weekend with Bob Ripley



The Australian Beechcraft Society is sponsoring Bob Ripley to come out to Australia to run a workshop for LAME's experienced on Beechcraft maintenance from Friday March 3 to Sunday March 5, 2023, at Wagga Wagga, NSW.

Bob is arguably the most knowledgeable Aircraft Engineer for these type of aircraft in the world. He has been the American Bonanza Society's Senior Technical Advisor for 15 years and has managed his own maintenance facility near Atlanta for nearly 40 years that focuses solely on piston Beechcraft. This program will provide LAME's from across Australia an opportunity to share some of his knowledge and experience.

This course is conducted across America regularly, but this will be the first of its kind in Australia.

The program will cover common squawks, and how to address them, with special emphasis on Beechcraft landing gear inspections, rigging and repair. There will be some seminars on common issues with piston Beechcraft maintenance and how to address them.

The course will be a 3 day event and limited to 20 LAMES, experienced on Beechcraft and General Aviation maintenance, 2 days will be a structured program and day 3 will be an informal session where LAMES can discuss or raise maintenance matters directly with Bob.

This will be a one-off incredible opportunity for LAME's servicing Beechcraft aircraft. The cost for attendees (whilst yet to be finalised) is anticipated to be \$400.00 for the first registration from an organisation and then \$250.00 thereafter. Attendees will be responsible for their accommodation and meals outside the event.
